

ESG Info-SASB

(Sustainability Accounting Standards Board)

- Founded in San Francisco in 2011, the Sustainability Accounting Standards Board (SASB) is a non-profit organization dedicated to developing sustainability accounting standards. In 2018, SASB introduced the Materiality Map, covering five dimensions, 11 sectors, 77 industries, and 26 universal ESG issues. This map identifies ESG topics that significantly impact financial performance and operations, providing a voluntary framework increasingly adopted by companies worldwide.
- Alongside GRI Standards, SASB plays a critical role in sustainability reporting by offering investors industry-specific ESG metrics with material financial implications. As sustainable finance products become a key focus for investors, investees, and global sustainability efforts, demand for transparent sustainability information has grown. Through disclosures aligned with SASB Standards, companies and investors can effectively communicate financially material ESG information.
- SASB indicators highlight industry-specific risks and opportunities, helping companies strengthen sustainability management and enabling investors to implement sustainable investment strategies—advancing global sustainability development.
